We invite you to join us for the 4th Annual Old Time Bluegrass Festival! We will highlight Bluegrass and Old Time Music and celebrate the history and heritage of Anderson Marsh State Historic Park during the years 1870—1930. We hope that our event will bring you back to the simple life. Anderson Marsh Interpretive Association, Clear Lake Chamber of Commerce and the Children's Museum of Art & Science will be bringing this year's Festival to you. This year the festival will be one day only & will highlight Old Time Bluegrass Music throughout the day with Arts & Crafts, Food, Music workshops, Art in the Barn & Wine & Beer Garden. We hope you will join us!

Criteria for Participants for the Arts/Crafts, Food & Art in the Barn:

- To keep the feeling of the late 1870's to early 1900's, we hope you will celebrate with us in attire of that era.
- Make sure that you have any permits, etc. that may be required. Any booths that have food products must contact the Health Dept and obtain the proper permits. Arts & Crafts booths, Food booths and Artists must have any resale licenses or business licenses that are required.
- Vendors from last year will have until June 15, 2009 to request their previous booth. After that booths will be assigned on a first come first serve basis at our discretion to make sure that similar booths aren't located close to one another. Note your choices on your application and we will attempt to come as close as possible.
- Accepted applications for A/C or Food will have their booths assigned by July 15, 2009 and you should receive your confirmation within 2 weeks after that. We will accept applications until September 6, 2009 as long as space is available.
- This is a juried show and we will accept only high quality items, hand-crafted by the seller. You may be asked to remove any non-juried items or items that lack desired quality.
- We would especially like old-time crafts (e.g., candle making, soap making, hand tooled leatherwork, etc.), but will accept any quality items handcrafted by you. Demonstrating your craft in your booth is desired, but not required.

Booths:

- Booth rent is \$35 for Arts & Crafts booths and \$70 for Food booths. Vendor space will be 15' x 15'. Each Vendor will provide all tables, chairs etc., and shade covering. (This is essential due to possible heat or rain) The Art in the Barn is limited space. If you choose to sell your work, there will be a 10% commission paid to the fundraiser. See applications for more info.

Set Up Time:

- Set up begins 2 - 6pm Fri., September 11, 2009 and will be completed by 9am, Sat., September 12th. All vehicles must be removed by that time.
- The gates open Saturday at 9:30am. Vendor parking will be provided as close as possible for the vendor's convenience.

Take Down Time:

- Take down at the festival closing is 6:30 pm. All vendors are expected to remain until that time. All participants are to be finished taking down by 8:30pm.

Overnight: Overnight security will be provided on Friday night. Vendors with self-contained vehicles may park overnight in the designated area on Friday for \$5 by prior arrangement only.
