## **AMIA Continues to lead Nature Walks & offer Ranch Tours at Anderson Marsh State Historic Park**

Anderson Marsh State Historic Park remains open and the Anderson Marsh Interpretive Association (AMIA) continues to hold its monthly guided nature walks, followed by a tour of the Historic Ranch House Museum, on the second Saturday of the month.

Some walks are completely ADA accessible. The ADA accessible walk goes from the Ranch House to where the Cache Creek boardwalk ends at the Creek. Some of the walks head onto Anderson Flats towards the Ridge or Marsh Trail. Call to confirm if the walk will be on the ADA trail only.

Bring your binoculars and meet in front of the Ranch House at 8:15am for time to experience the early morning wildlife to be found in the Ranch House and Barn complex yard – walk begins at 8:30am.

Experience the Park with docents as they share knowledge of the geologic, natural and Native American history of the area as well as the European Immigrant experience.

If rain cancels the walk, the ranch tour will begin at 8:30am.

After the Ranch House tour, come and see what the AMIA store has to offer – note cards, t-shirts, hats & more.

Anderson Marsh State Historic Park is located on Hwy 53, between Lower Lake and Clearlake.
